


Vandenwildenberg, 2008 WL 508697, at *1 (E.D. Wis. 2008) (“Inherent in the authority to allow a defendant the opportunity to voluntarily surrender to begin serving his or her sentence is the authority to delay the date on which the sentence may commence for good cause and within reasonable limits.”). As noted above, the United States does not object to a one-week delay in Mr. Fennell’s reporting date. Therefore, being duly advised, the Court **GRANTS IN PART** and **DENIES IN PART** Mr. Fennell’s request and **ORDERS** that Mr. Fennell report to the location designated by the Bureau of Prisons on **June 6, 2018**, before 2 p.m.
