

Detour Map

Southbound Traffic

Exit the Parkway at milepost 262.5, McCullough Blvd, and head east.

In about 1.8 miles, follow signs to get on HWY 45 South.

In about 4.8 miles, get on HWY 278, Pontotoc Parkway heading west.

In about 4.25 miles get back on the Natchez Trace Parkway heading south.

Northbound Traffic

Exit the Parkway at milepost 257 and head east on HWY 278, Pontotoc Parkway

In about 4.25 miles get on HWY 45 North

In about 4.87 miles exit to the left, following signs for McCullough Blvd.

In about 1.8 miles get back on the Natchez Trace Parkway heading north.

Bicyclists might want to find an alternate route fitting their experience and ability level. The route linked the below was not developed by the Parkway, but is provided by Natchez Trace Travel, who assists bicyclists in trip planning. (Or hire a shuttle)
