FOOTBALL GUIDELINES

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Per State and MHSAA guidelines, **MASKS MUST BE ON PROPERLY WHEN ENTERING THE STADIUM AND MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES.** You will be asked to leave if you do not abide by these regulations.
- Children must stay with their parents/guardians at all times. There will be no more playing around the bleachers on either side.
- When in line at the concession stand or restrooms, please use **Social Distancing**.
- Home fans will need to park behind the home bleachers.
- Visiting fans will need to park in the student parking lot in front of the high school.
- Guidelines could be revised in the event the Governor changes the Executive Order.

TICKET SALES FOR FRIDAY VARSITY GAMES

- Every student-athlete or activity member participating in the game (player, cheerleader, band, manager) will be allowed to purchase 2 tickets each @ **\$8.00** per ticket on Thursdays before each home game at the high school office.
- Tickets for the visiting team will be mailed to the school. The visiting school's administrator will be responsible for selling tickets and will bring a check and/or tickets on the day of the game.
- Any extra tickets for home games will be 1st come 1st serve for students from 8:00 am-12:00 pm Friday at the high school office. We will announce on Facebook (Calhoun City High School) & Twitter (@calhouncityhs) if there are any extra tickets.

TICKET SALES FOR MONDAY JR. HIGH/JR. VARSITY GAMES

- Tickets will be sold on the Friday before the game is to be played the next week. Each participant will be allowed to purchase 2 tickets at **\$5.00** each.
- Tickets for the visiting team will be mailed to the school. The visiting school's administrator will be responsible for selling tickets and will bring a check and/or tickets on the day of the game.
- Any tickets not sold will be available for students on game day from 8:00 am-12:00 pm at the high school office.
