Today at Fremont Middle School we were notified of a POSSIBLE threat by a student by the Winston Police Department. As soon as we were informed about the threat, we took action. The student was brought to the office and parents were notified. We cooperated with the Winston Police Department in their investigation. We followed our district policy with regards to the threat and can make no further comment with regards to disciplinary action.

At this time, we have no reason to believe there was an imminent threat. We are again asking parents to remind children and teens that making any kind of threat, even in jest, carries serious consequences. All of us at Fremont Middle School will continue to make student safety our top priority.
