WILKERSON, WALTER

ON 10/29/2017 AT 19:12 HOURS I, OFFICER CASSIDY JUMPER, WAS DISPATCHED TO THE SHOE DEPT., LOCATED INSIDE THE MALL AT BARNES CROSSING AT 1001 BARNES CROSSING ROAD IN REFERENCE TO A POSSIBLE ARMED ROBBERY.

UPON ARRIVAL, I ENTERED THE MALL AT THE DOOR WAY ON THE WEST SIDE, BETWEEN ULTA AND D'CASA. I MADE MY WAY TO THE BUSINESS, WHERE I IMMEDIATELY SAW A WHITE FEMALE, THAT APPEARED TO HAVE DUCT TAPE AROUND THE BACK OF HER HEAD AND AROUND ONE OF HER ANKLES. I THEN NOTICED ANOTHER FEMALE LAYING FACE DOWN, IN ONE OF THE ISLES. I MADE MY WAY OVER AND NOTICED SHE HAD SCRATCHES ON HER ARMS, AND SHE WAS COMPLAINING ABOUT HER BACK HURTING. I UPDATED DISPATCH ON THE VICTIMS, FOR MEDICS. WHILE I WAS IN THE STORE, I NOTICED THAT A LEE COUNTY DEPUTY WAS INSIDE, ALONG WITH A SECURITY GUARD FROM THE MALL.

I BEGIN TO SPEAK TO THE FEMALE EMPLOYEE WITH THE DUCT TAPE ON HER. SHE WAS IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] BEGAN TO ASK [REDACTED] ABOUT THE DESCRIPTION OF THE SUSPECT. [REDACTED] DESCRIBED THE SUSPECT AS A DARK SKINNED BLACK MALE, WEARING A KHAKI COAT, WITH SEVERAL LAYERS OF CLOTHES, WITH A BANDANNA AROUND HIS FACE, SKINNY AND APPROXIMATELY 5'11. I THEN UPDATED OFFICERS THAT WERE ON THE WAY TO THE SCENE AND IN THE AREA.

I THEN STATED TO ASK [REDACTED] WHAT HAPPENED. [REDACTED] STATED THAT SHE WAS CLEANING UP, AND CAME TO THE REGISTER AREA TO GET TRASH BAGS AND THEN WENT TO THE BACK TO THE RESTROOM. [REDACTED] STATED THAT WHEN SHE OPENED THE DOOR TO THE RESTROOM, THE MALE WAS STANDING THERE. [REDACTED] STATES THAT THE MALE CAME OUT AND STARTED BEATING HER IN THE HEAD WITH A GUN, CAUSING A CUT ON HER FINGER. [REDACTED] STATES THAT THE MALE THEN TAPED HER UP, AND DRUG HER INTO THE BATHROOM, AND LOCKED THE DOOR. [REDACTED] STATES THAT SHE STAYED IN THE BATHROOM FOR APPROXIMATELY 10-15 MINUTES, AND GOT OUT. [REDACTED] STATES THAT SHE CAME OUTSIDE, AND NOTICED THE OTHER EMPLOYEE, [REDACTED] LAYING IN AN ISLE. [REDACTED] STATES THAT SHE THEN CALLED FOR HELP. WHILE THERE, I NOTICED THAT [REDACTED] WAS CARRYING A YELLOW BOX CUTTER. I ASKED WHERE SHE HAD GOTTEN IT, SHE STATED THAT THERE WAS A BOX OF THEM IN THE BACK AND THAT SHE USED IT TO GET THE DUCT TAPE OFF. I THEN ASKED [REDACTED] IF SHE KNEW OF ANYTHING MISSING FROM THE STORE, SHE REPLIED THE MONEY. I ASKED IF SHE KNEW HOW MUCH, SHE ADVISED POSSIBLY \$2,000.00. I ASKED WHERE THE MONEY WAS AT, SHE ADVISED ME THE LAST TIME SHE SAW IT, IT WAS LAYING ON THE REGISTER. WHEN ASKED ABOUT HOW THE SUSPECT GOT INTO THE BUILDING, SHE STATED THAT THE GATES WERE DOWN IN THE FRONT, SO POSSIBLY THE BACK. WHEN ASKED ABOUT LOOKING AT THEIR CAMERAS, SHE ADVISED THAT THEY DIDN'T WORK. I ASKED ABOUT ANYONE WE COULD SPEAK WITH TO LOOK AT THEM AND SHE GIVE ME STORE MANAGER, [REDACTED] NUMBER.

I THEN MADE MY WAY TO THE SECOND VICTIM, WHO WAS BEING TREATED BY TUPELO FIRE DEPARTMENT, UNTIL MEDICS ARRIVED. SHE WAS IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED] STATES THAT SHE WAS VACUUMING, AND THEN REMEMBERS BEING SHAKEN BY [REDACTED] THE OTHER EMPLOYEE, ASKING IF SHE WAS OK. [REDACTED] ADVISED THAT SHE DIDN'T REMEMBER WHAT HAPPENED. I WAS INFORMED BY THE FIRE DEPARTMENT THAT [REDACTED] HAD A LARGE KNOT ON HER HEAD, AND COMPLAINING OF BACK AND NECK PAIN.

DEPUTY KILGO STATES THAT WHEN HE ARRIVED, THAT [REDACTED] WAS MAKING HER WAY OUT OF THE STORE, AND SHE THEN TOOK HIM OVER TO THE OTHER VICTIM. DEPUTY KILGO ADVISED THAT NEAR [REDACTED] A BLADE WAS LAYING IN THE FLOOR BESIDE HER. I BEGIN TO SPEAK WITH THE FIREMEN, WHO WERE WORKING WITH [REDACTED] THEY ADVISED THEY HAD PLACED THE BLADE ON A WOOD BENCH NEAR WHERE [REDACTED] WAS LAYING. PICTURES OF THE

BLADE WERE TAKEN.

WHILE ON SCENE, I ATTEMPTED TO MAKE CONTACT WITH THE MANAGER [REDACTED]. I CALLED [REDACTED] MULTIPLE TIMES, AND CONTINUED TO BUT NO CONTACT. FINALLY AT 20:35 HOURS [REDACTED] WAS NOTIFIED AND ASKED TO RESPOND TO THE SCENE.

WHILE THERE, SGT. WILKERSON WAS NOTIFIED, ALONG WITH DETECTIVES. OFFICER BRITTNEY WILLIAMS KEPT A LIST OF PEOPLE ENTERING THE CRIME SCENE:
