**STRAIGHT PARTY INSTRUCTIONS:** To vote a straight party ticket for all candidates of a political party on this ballot, except for candidates described below, make a voting mark on or in this oval and do not make any other marks on this ballot.  
**\*To vote for any candidate for an at-large office (county council), you must make another voting mark for each candidate you wish to vote for. Your straight party vote will not count as a vote for any candidate for that office.**  
 \*If you wish to vote for a candidate seeking a nonpartisan office or on a public question or judicial retention question, you must make another voting mark on the appropriate place on this ballot.  
**SPLIT-TICKET VOTING:** You may vote a Split Party Ticket by marking ONE of the party choices and then voting for individual candidates of your choice in any other party OR you may vote for individual candidates of your choice in each office.  
**PRESIDENTIAL ELECTORS:** A ballot cast for the named candidates for President and Vice President of the United States is considered a ballot cast for the slate of presidential electors nominated by that political party or independent candidate.
