6 WHEREAS, the Coos County Board of Commissioners represents an estimated 64,000 people;
7 and

8 WHEREAS, the residents of Coos County have endured for many years of the impacts from
9 wildfire smoke, lack of timber harvest and the improper management of timber lands in and
10 around our county which has and continues to severely impact our economy; and

11 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will directly increase the utility costs and fuel costs that will further
12 burden the residents of Coos County who are already burdened by the increasing cost of living
13 in our county through delivered goods and services which are dependent on truck
14 transportation; and

15 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will directly increase the cost to Coos County and the residents of
16 Coos County by causing significant increases in fuel costs; and


17 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will significantly hinder the ability of Coos County residents to
18 recover from years of economic decline caused by adverse public land policies; and

19 WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1530 will not reduce the CO2 in the atmosphere.

21 Oregon is opposed to Senate Bill 1530 of the 80th Oregon Legislative Assembly which will have
