

# THREE RIVERS SCHOOL DISTRICT RETURN TO SCHOOL PLAN 2020



## On-site Learning at a Local Three Rivers School



When the health metrics required by the Oregon Health Authority and the Oregon Department of Education are met, students will return to in-person learning at their regular school under COVID-19 protocols.

## Distance Learning At Home

When COVID infection rates are above allowable levels in the county, on-site learning will be suspended and distance learning will begin. Once infection rates fall below maximum levels, students will transition back to on-site learning at the start of the next quarter.



### Distance Learning at home will include the following:

- Students will engage in learning virtually with their local TRSD educator(s) using the same on-site, approved classroom curriculum.
- **CANVAS**, TRSD's centralized learning management system, will coordinate all student/classroom/school information.
- Daily schedules will include live learning sessions with mandatory participation.
- Teachers will provide regular student check-in times as well as regularly offer peer-to-peer engagements.
- Student support services such as SPED, EL, counselors, and others will be provided by assigned teacher(s) and support staff.
- Standard letter grading and reporting of grades will continue.

### Oregon Department of Ed. REQUIREMENTS TO REOPEN

#### County Metrics

1.  $\leq 10$  cases per 100,000 for three (3) consecutive weeks
2.  $\leq 5\%$  positive test rate in the preceding seven (7) days

#### State Metrics

3.  $\leq 5\%$  positive test rate in the preceding seven (7) days

## K-3 Exception



If ODE health metrics for exception status are met, the following guidelines will apply **ONLY** to grades K-3.

- On-site learning Mon.-Thu.
- Students cohorts (groups) for physical distancing.
- Face masks required for all.

**ALL** TRSD students will be assigned a digital device to use at home to complete assignments. This applies to either learning option.

## Fully Virtual K-12 Program
